2023-24 ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Interested in making a difference in your lodge by being an officer on the Board? The Nominating Committee will have the first meeting on Jan 19th. Complete and turn in a Nomination Form available in the Social Quarters. There is a book that explains the qualifications and duties for each position. Below is a short outline. If you have any questions, talk to an Officer.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR ELECTED OFFICERS:

Must be an active member of the Lodge.

Must also be an active member of either a Legion or a Chapter unit (or establish such active membership within sixty (60) day following Installation).

General Duties and Responsibilities –

The general duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

PRESIDENT:

- Be the fraternal leader of the Lodge
- Preside at meetings
- Appoint officers, establish and appoint committee chairpersons
- Count votes (not ballots) and inspect records
- Maintain order
- Increase membership
- Improve the financial strength of the Lodge
- Represent the Lodge as a delegate to the International Convention, association conferences, conventions and district meetings.

VICE PRESIDENT:

- Preside over Lodge in absence or vacancy of the President
- Assist President with Lodge order and decorum

TREASURER:

- Inspect Lodge financial records and receipts
- Custodian of securities
- Perform Administrator duties in Administrator’s absence
- Authorize and sign checks

CHAPLAIN:

- Serve on the Financial Review Committee
- Contact or visit the sick, disabled and distressed

TRUSTEES: (1 Year, 2 Year and 3 Year)

- Take inventories
- Examine and approve bills
- Serve on Loss Prevention Committee
- Perform inspections of the facility and property

RAISE THE ROOF FACTS:

- Membership vote result – Replace the Roof
- Membership vote result – Alcon’s Roofing was chosen as the contractor
- The contract has been signed and submitted
- Moose International has approved the dispensation to replace the roof
- Total donations collected to date equal \$37,802.
- Budget to replace the roof and repair unknown damage: \$50k to \$55k
- Remaining donations needed: \$13k to \$18k

Thank you to all of our generous members that have donated. To date we have raised almost 75% of what is needed to replace our leaking roof. The fundraising efforts are continuing. **Donations are still being accepted and are still needed to reach our goal.**

Once the weather cooperates and the required permit is secured, the contractor will put us on their schedule. The funds will need to be available when the work begins.

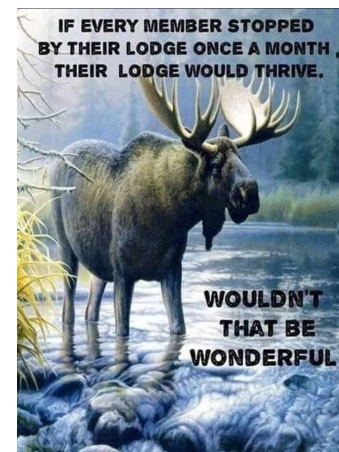
