#### ALL MOOSE MEMBERS SHOULD KNOW THIS:

- You must carry and show your membership card every time you enter your lodge.

Members must have a current membership card or the app to be on their person. This is why our bartenders or officers on duty ask to see your card. It's their job. Some organizations may not enforce the IRS rules and could be in jeopardy of losing their tax free status and their Private Club liquor license. Our Moose Lodge does NOT want this to happen, so PLEASE let's be PROUD - SHOW YOUR MOOSE CARD.
