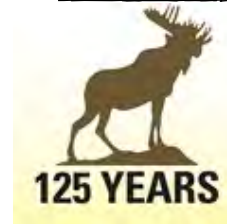

Moose will be going "Back to Basics" in 2014-15

Basic training for our members will begin with our new membership campaign, appropriately titled "Moose – Back to Basics." We are asking our brothers and co-workers to stand shoulder-to-shoulder and reinvigorate our fraternal bond by becoming advocates on behalf of the Moose. 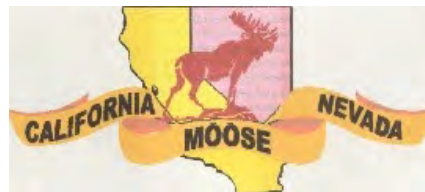
