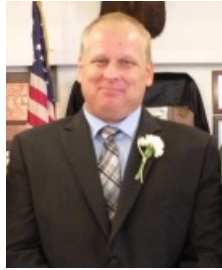

Although I still haven't returned to work, I'm doing my duties as Administrator again. I still have a little trouble going down stairs, but I know that will improve.

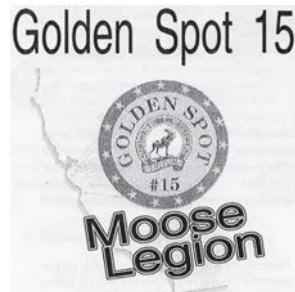
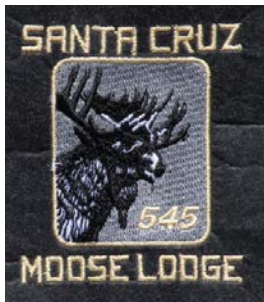
