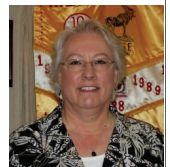


In the month of June, fifteen special hand-made blankets were

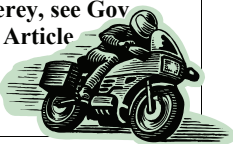
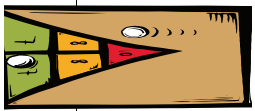
