And remember, we want you at our lodge more often!

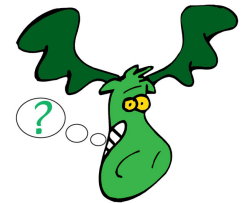


