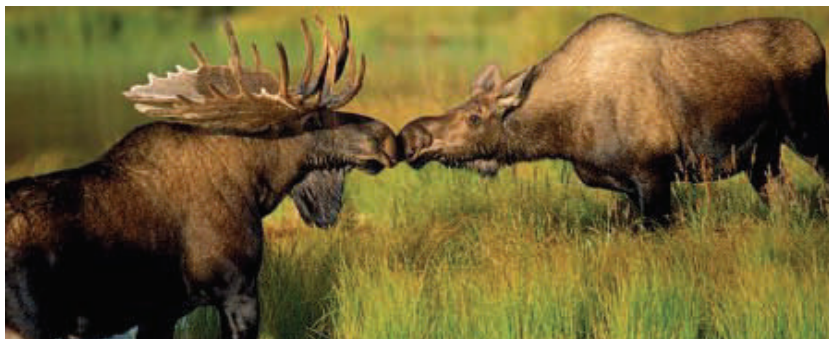

the best and friendliest Lodge in the Fraternity.

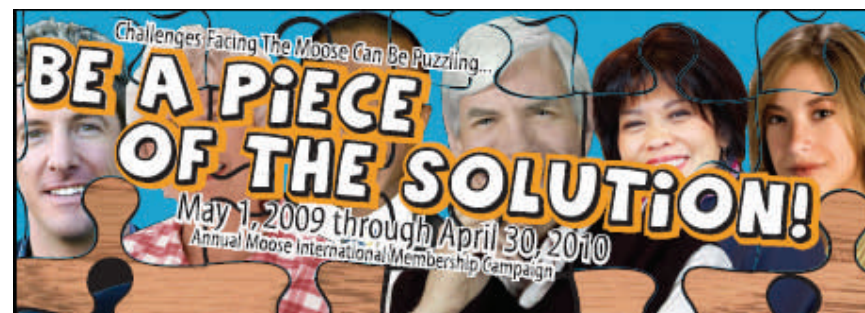

ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY VOLUNTEER CALL!

Members and Friends of 545,

Once again Santa Cruz has been charged with the Adopt-A-Highway program of keeping our highways clean. In years past 545 kept Highway 17 free of litter in front of our lodge with monthly clean-ups. Please see picture of past volunteers. We lost that assignment when Cal-Trans deemed that stretch of highway unsafe for the AAH volunteers. Over the years I have lobbied for a replacement program, one that would be close to the Lodge and convenient for meeting and storage of all safety items. We have been rewarded with the Pasatiempo Park and Ride area! We have received our Encroachment Permit and I will be attending a safety orientation at the site on Tuesday, May 4, 2pm for about an hour. At that time we will receive our safety items and our AAH sign will be ordered to go up.



Our permit states that we must clean up the site once a month so what I am asking for is about a dozen volunteers. I will divide us into two groups with an assigned lead. They would then be tasked with a clean up every other month so that you would only have to clean up six times per year. We would meet at the Lodge at 0830 on the Saturday clean up, distribute our safety supplies (safety glasses, gloves, vests, pickers, hard hats and litter bags) and then roll to Pasatiempo a couple of miles to the South. If OK with your lead, you may then leave your safety items with the lead, and can be dismissed directly from the site rather than return to the Lodge.

Our first clean up is scheduled for Saturday, May 22, 8:30am. We will meet at the Lodge in order to go over critical safety items and distribute our safety supplies. I will have do-nuts! If we are diligent with this task our monthly clean ups will be easy and our good name will be attached to our good work!

A Plea to the Veterans of Moose Lodge 545

For the past 35 years, the members of the Santa Cruz Military Officers Association of America (MOAA) have honored our deceased Veterans each Memorial



Day, July 4th and Veterans Day. On these days, the original cast-iron flags of about 400 deceased veterans have been flown in the cemetery on Paul Sweet Road next to Dominican hospital.

Now, after 35 years, the average age of the MOAA members is now high in the 80s. These veterans find it more difficult each time to put the flags up and return them to storage.

THEY NEED OUR HELP. Without our help, this may be the last year the 400 flags in the AVENUE of FLAGS will fly. Santa Cruz Moose Lodge 545 has a large number of Veteran in our membership. In our lodge, our average age is much younger than MOAA. As Veterans, I know that each of you would agree with me that our departed Veteran Brothers and Sisters, that served to keep our nation free, deserve to be remembered this way. I hope you Veterans join me in not wanting this tradition to come to an end.

I encourage the Veterans of 545 to join me and become partners with MOAA in this worthwhile effort. It will only take a few hours of your time each year on these three days and you will feel good about it.

On these three days each year, we put the flags up in the morning and take them down in the afternoon and store them away until the next time.

It is my hope that Lodge 545 can combine Displaying the Avenue of Flags with our regular holiday celebrations and make it a regular part of our annual service to the community.

I would like to have anyone interested and especially you vets; contact me and let's set up a meeting at the lodge some evening early in May and get this organized.

\$2,048 for Big Brother, Big Sisters!**



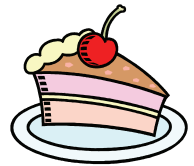

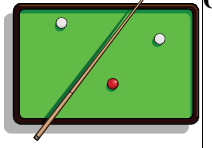
