As far as the games go:

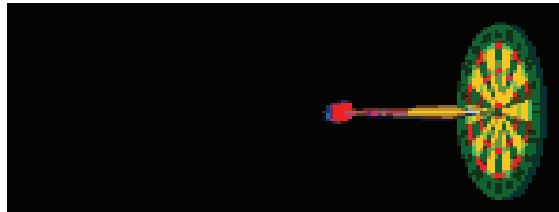
