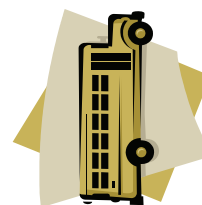

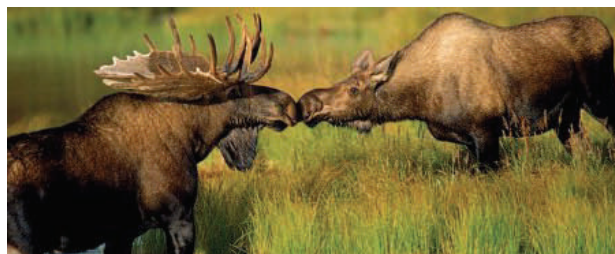

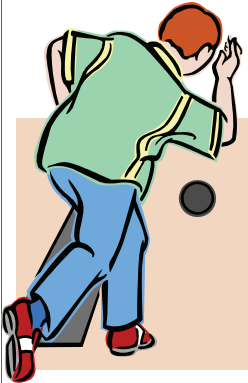

CUPCAKE CONTEST! And more **By Myra...**

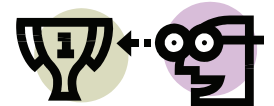

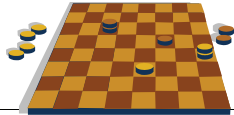
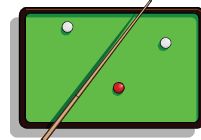
