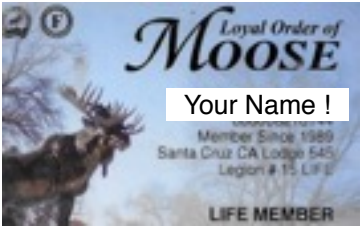

A new program that was announced during the International Convention in Nashville, Moose Rewards, provides valuable incentives to our members. Please remember that for each new or re-enrolled member that is sponsored during the "Moose – Raise the Roof" campaign, your members will receive Moose Rewards points that they can eventually redeem for offerings important to them. For members who sponsor their first candidate "ever," they will receive 6,000 points, which is nearly enough in itself to reach the first redemption level. 
